Background/History

On 9/17/19, an inter-local agreement between the City of Edmonds and the Edmonds School District was approved by full Council during their regularly scheduled meeting. Upon being signed by the Mayor, the agreement was sent back to the District for signatures. Even though the agreement had been sent to the City as a final, approved draft prior to being brought before Council, District staff determined there were changes to the agreement that they wanted made and sent the agreement back to the City. Those changes do not change the overall intent of the agreement, however, the changes are significant enough that the agreement does need to be brought back to Council for approval.

Staff Recommendation

Staff requests and recommends approval by the full Council.

Narrative

This inter-local agreement outlines a protocol for both the Edmonds School District and the Edmonds Police Department when a law enforcement need arises wherein video surveillance footage needs to be viewed in the furtherance of public safety, particularly of the school staff and student population.

The inter-local agreement is attached (as is the previous version approved by Council on 9/17/20) and has been approved as to form by the Edmonds City Attorney's Office.
